Presentación de la Escuela

You have just opened a new high school and you're trying to build enrollment. You and 2 or 3 other students will create a presentation about your school for 9th grade preview night to try to encourage students to enroll. Your presentation should include a visual aid that engages both the students and their families interested in your school. You may use pictures, images, clip art, maps, etc. to present your information but **YOU MAY NOT HAVE ANY WORDS ON YOUR VISUAL**. Be creative in your development of your school and how you present it; however, your school should still follow the outline of what a school is and that the focus is education.

Your presentation should include at least the following information:

- Introduction of group members
- General information about school (Name, size, specialty, etc.)
- In general, how are the students at your school?
- In general, how are the teachers at your school?
- What is a typical day like for a student at the school?
 - What does a typical schedule look like? Where do students go and when?
 - What do students have to bring to classes?
- Where are the main facilities located at the school?
 - Library, gymnasium, cafeteria, etc.?
 - When do students go to these places?
- How are the classes?
 - What are some of the classes offered?
 - What are some favorite classes?
 - What do students need to do to ensure good grades? How often do they need to do these things?
- How do students feel at the school?

You will be using mostly vocabulary from Unit 2, but you may use any previous vocabulary needed as well. Your visual can be a powerpoint, prezi or a video and you can also use props, costumes, music, or anything else to "sell" your school. Be creative and make sure it is appropriate in content. Have fun with the language, but stick to things you know how to say; don't try to google translate things or present something that is not your work.

Your presentation is worth 100 points and will be based on the following:

_____ / 15 **Fluidity/Preparation:** The best way to assure full credit in this category is to **practice, practice, practice**. You will not have your script with you when you present, so you should prepare well enough to say your lines without major problems. The skit should flow from one student to another and each person should be confident in their lines. There should be no long pauses or awkward transitions.

_____ / 15 **Content:** You should answer all questions in the project description and give any other information necessary to present your school. Each student should have an equitable amount of dialogue.

_____ / 10 **Vocabulary:** You may use any relevant vocabulary, but your main focus should be vocabulary from Unit 2, which will also be good review for your unit test. For a perfect score in this category, each person must use a variety of **at least 10 well placed** and correctly used vocabulary words/phrases from the unit.

_____ / 20 **Grammar:** While your grammar may not be 100% perfect, your presentation should reflect that you have practiced and that you have mastery of the concepts we have been covering since the beginning of the year. Each student should have correct conjugations of *tener* and *tener que*, present tense of *-ar* verbs, the verb *estar*, and the verb *ir*.

_____ / 20 **Delivery and Pronunciation:** Your facial expressions, body language and appropriate tone are used to engage the audience. You should also speak loudly and clearly and make eye contact with your audience. Although I do not expect you to sound like a native speaker, I do expect that you are making effort in your pronunciation. Remember the “h” is always silent, “ll” makes a /y/ sound and each vowel has a precise sound.

_____ / 20 **Overall Presentation:** How well do you follow the requirements in the project description? Is your presentation original, creative, appropriate in content and is it entertaining? Does your speaking have a logical sequence and flow?
