

## Subjunctive with Doubt

**expression of doubt** + **que** + **different subject** + **subjunctive**

Marta **no está segura de** que **tengamos** tiempo para ver la película.

Note that the word **no** can affect whether or not you need to use the **subjunctive**.

↙ *expresses certainty* ↘ *indicative*

**No dudamos** que él **tiene** talento.

**We do not doubt** that he *has* talent.

## Subjunctive with Emotion

**expression of emotion** + **que** + **different subject** + **subjunctive**

**Nos alegramos de** que tú **actúes** con honor.

*We're happy* that you *act with honor*.

**No me sorprendo de** que sea difícil.

*I'm not surprised* that it's difficult.

## Superlatives.

Follow this formula to talk about superlatives:

**el / la / los / las + noun + más + adjective** (*agrees with article and noun*)

Ana Maria es **la artista más famosa** que conozco

*Ana Maria is the most famous artist I know.*

## Subjunctive with Ojalá and Verbs of Hope

**Verbs of Hope** + **que** + **different subject** + **subjunctive**

desear  
esperar  
querer

Ella **quiere** que su **hijo se comporte** bien.

Use the **infinitive** and omit **que** if there is no change of subject.

El niño **quiere comportarse** bien.

**Ojalá** can be used with or without **que**. It is always used with the subjunctive.

**Ojalá que** no llueva mañana.

## Subjunctive with Verbs of Influence

## Verbs of Influence

aconsejar dejar exigir	insistir mandar pedir	prohibir recomendar sugerir
------------------------------	-----------------------------	-----------------------------------

verb of influence + **que** + **different subject** + **subjunctive**

*indicative* →

**Sugiero** que **llegues** temprano.

*I suggest* that you *arrive early*.

↙ *subjunctive*

## Suffixes.

Many adjectives can be changed to nouns by adding common suffixes. **-Cia, -ez, -dad,** and **-cion** create feminine nouns.

## Adjective

paciente

*patient*

## Noun

la **paciencia**

*patience*

sincero

*sincere*

la **sinceridad**

*sincerity*
